### **THE RICHARD CATLOW SCHOLARSHIPS**

#### **Background**

This is awarded annually in memory of the late Richard Catlow, a distinguished Member of the Club and in recognition of his considerable contribution to golf in Northamptonshire and at NCGC over a period of some 70 years. This award will support and develop junior potential at NCGC.

#### **Purpose of the Award**

To assist qualifying Junior Golfers with the financial costs associated with entering County, Regional and National Competitions e.g. Entry Fees, Travelling Expenses, etc.  
N.B. Applications will not be considered for coaching fees or golf equipment.

#### **Annual Total Amount Available**

An amount equivalent to the current NCGC Adult Full Playing Membership Subscription at the time of the Application.

#### **Who May Apply?**

Only Applications from “Fully Paid Up” Junior Members of NCGC who regard NCGC as their “Home Club” will be considered.

#### **Application Process**

- Applications will be invited annually from the NCGC Junior Membership
- Upon request, Application Forms will be made available.
- The Application Form will request details of the Applicant’s Background, Golf Experience and Achievements.
- In addition, the Applicant will be required to give details of their Golfing Objectives/Aspirations including their competitive Golfing Program for the year together with the Financial Support required and a Personal Statement...
- The Application will require Comment and Assessment from their Professional/Coach and must be countersigned by a Parent.
- Applications must be lodged by 15<sup>th</sup> March each year and will, in the first instance, be considered by the Junior Development Committee who will make recommendations to the Management Committee who in turn will make the Award(s).
